



Third Space Brewing Give20 Program Overview

Partner with Third Space Brewing to raise funds and awareness for your non-profit!

The goal of the Give20 Program is to give area non-profits an opportunity to raise awareness for the great work that you do and to raise some additional funds in the process.

Our Give20 Program allows Milwaukee nonprofits associated with youth development or homelessness to host a Give20 Night in our tap room to spread the word about your organization and to raise funds to aid in your efforts. We will donate 20% of the night's proceeds back to your organization.

Apply online or in person by filling out our Give20 Application Form. If accepted, Third Space will work with you to coordinate a Wednesday or Thursday night that works for your nonprofit to host the event in our tap room.

From there, you invite your friends, family, and other supporters into the tap room to make the fundraiser the best it can be. We will reserve a few tables for you to gather with your group or to set out information about your organization. At the end of the night, we will donate 20% of our beer sales back to your organization.

Your nonprofit is allowed to and encouraged to promote the event through your own social media platforms leading up to the event to drum up interest and participation. Third Space will share the Give20 Program story and may include your event in the promotion.

Youth Development and Homelessness

We have limited participation in the Give20 program to groups working on Youth Development and Homelessness because both issues are important to our team. If your organization does not fall into these two categories, you will not be selected.

Why Youth Development?

Our Co-Founders, Andy & Kevin, met as summer camp counselors at YMCA Camp Minikani. They each dedicated a portion of their young lives to working with children so they understand the impact great youth programming can have on a child's life.

Why Homelessness?

Homelessness is a growing issue in the community where our brewery is located, the Menomonee River Valley. It is also a mission of our company to help all people enjoy their "third space." We say: "You have your home, you have your work, but everyone needs a Third Space." It is difficult to enjoy a "third space" if you don't have a first space, your home.
